

## LOCAL RULES

1. A ball is out of bounds if it comes to rest:-
  - a) Beyond the boundary of the course.
  - b) Beyond white boundary posts.
  - c) On the driving range.
  - d) All protective fences are integral parts of the course. (No relief).
2. Relief must be taken from any tree or shrub under 2 metres, in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b. No Penalty.
3. Players on the 1st men's medal tee have priority over players on the 18th green.
4. 6th & 18th hole - to speed up play would players on the putting surface wave to the group waiting on the tee to play up to the green.
5. Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Stones which interfere with the execution of a stroke may be removed. If the ball moves it must be replaced in the hazard as near to the spot from which it was moved, but not nearer the hole - no penalty (Rule 24/1 applies R & A).
6. All pop-up sprinkler heads and hydrants are immovable obstructions and relief from them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. See also Page 87 Part B-1 fixed sprinkler heads further relief within two club-lengths of the green.
7. Electric Cables. If your ball strikes a power line a new ball must be played from the original spot where that ball was played (Rule 20-5). No penalty.
8. Pathways. Stone paths and path edges and the flower bed at the 1st hole are immovable obstructions. The ball may be dropped without penalty at the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole. Rule 24-2(i) applies. Except when the path is an artificial bridge over a hazard.
9. Dropping zones. Where available, dropping zones must be used. If your ball enters the water hazard from the teeing ground on Hole 18 you have the option to play from the drop zone on the island.
10. 100 & 150 yard markers are to green centre.
11. Out of bounds white marker posts. No relief. Penalty drop as Rule 24-1. No out of bounds to the rear or left side of green when playing Hole 7. Internal out of bounds on Hole 8 and Hole 14. All fencing around the Farm is O.O.B. and no retrieval of ball.
12. Any tractor or lorry marks or tracks in the rough or fairways shall be defined as ground under repair and this ball may be lifted and dropped in accordance with Rule 25-1 b(i). All soiled areas unless marked G.U.R. the ball must be played as it lies.
13. Please be aware of Public Footpaths on and around the course. Thank you.
